



Dye and Seal

Different types of finishing techniques and curing methods will alter the finished appearance of Liquid Color. A job-site-sample or test slab should be done using the specified materials, as well as the finishing and curing techniques that will be used on the project. Batch to batch uniformity must be maintained to produce consistent color.

Custom Colors: With this system virtually any pre-established industry color can be matched with minimal lead time. Non-established colors can also be matched with longer lead times. Contact MR Deco Concrete for more information. Different colors in cement, as well as some sands and water content, will result in different colors.

BASE COLOR: The colors on this color chart approximate laboratory samples of troweled concrete made from a 6-sack mix, using Type II Gray Portland Cement (see base color sample), Silica Sand, and water to achieve a 4" slump.

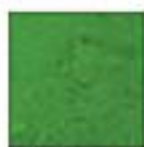
